General Tender Terms & Conditions:

The Maharashtra Agro-Industries Development Corporation Limited, Mumbai henceforth, referred to as the MAIDC, has set up and in operation Agro-Engineering workshop at Chinchwad, Pune with an existing production capacity, is available on long term leave and license basis.

The MAIDC is also interested to manufacture Drip, Sprinkler irrigation, HDPE Pipes and all other Agro-Engineering Implements.

1. Address & Location: -

The location is at Plot No. 52, D-2 Block, MIDC Industrial Area, Opp. Exide Industries, Pune - 411019.

2. RFP Bids: -

- a) There shall be two bids, one is of technical bid and the second is of commercial.
- b) The eligibility of bidder shall be verified by opening the technical bids.
- c) The MAIDC's own discretion commercial bids may be opened that of technically qualified bidders only.

3. Pre-bid Meeting: -

There shall be pre bid meeting on 09/11/2023 11.00 am at 'Krushiudyog' Bhavan, Aarey Milk Colony, Goregaon (E) Mumbai 400065, at head office of the MAIDC.

4. Factory Inspection: -

The bidder shall visit and inspect the factory premises at Chinchwad, Pune before participating in RFP for Leave and License henceforth, termed as 'AEW' on all working days except Thursdays.

5. Bid Fee & Earnest Money Deposit:-

- a) The nonrefundable cost of RFP bid form shall be Rs. 25,500/ (Rs. Twenty-Five Thousand and Five Hundred only) (including GST). The bid fee shall be paid online.
- b) The bidder shall pay an interest free Earnest Money Deposit of Rs. 25,00,000/- (Rs. Twenty Five Lakhs only) online.
- c) The earnest money of unsuccessful bidder shall be refunded in due course of time after completion of RFP entire procedure and allotment of contract (AoC) without any interest.
- d) The MSME's shall be exempted from payment of Bid fee & EMD.

6. Bidders Disqualification: -

- a) Bidder shall be out rightly disqualified for Incomplete/ Non-submission of any of the documents referred in technical bid.
- b) Incomplete, technical and commercial bids shall also be liable to be disqualified.

7. Agreement Signing: -

- a) The successful bidder shall have to sign and execute an agreement for long term leave and license on non-judicial bond paper and register the agreement to the appropriate authorities. The registrations fees shall be paid by bidder only.
- b) The MAIDC and bidder commits each other for leave and license and for manufacturing of Drip, Sprinkler irrigation, HDPE Pipes and all other agro-engineering implements in the MAIDC '**Krushi Udyog**' Brand as well as in its own Brand.
- c) The bidder and the MAIDC shall abide the terms and conditions mentioned herein and the agreement to be signed with successful bidder.

8. Security Deposit: -

- a) The successful bidder shall pay an interest free refundable security deposit of Rs.25,00,000/- (Rs. Twenty Five Lakhs Only) to The MAIDC either in the form of D.D./RTGS/NEFT/Bank performance guarantee.
- b) The earnest money can be adjusted into the security deposit of a successful Bidder.
- c) The security deposit shall be refunded in due course of time after satisfactory completion of leave and license period and conciliation of accounts without any interest.

9. Factory Capacity Utilization: -

- a) The bidder shall be responsible for the production as per BIS quality standards as & when demanded by The MAIDC products on priority without failure.
- b) The bidder shall be bound to supply the MAIDC products as per time line mentioned on the MAIDC indent or delivery orders.
- c) The bidder shall have absolute right and may use spare capacity of the factory, for its own brand Drip Irrigation, Sprinkle / HDPE Pipe products or any other brand desired by the bidder.
- d) The MAIDC shall not have any legal or any other specific or nonspecific reason to prevent the bidder for utilization of spare capacity for production of the Drip & sprinkler Irrigation, HDPE Pipes and or other products as desired the bidder.

10. Operations & Maintenance: -

The MAIDC shall not be the part of operations in any manner whatsoever or shall not share any consumable costs, operating costs at any stage of operation.

11. Leave & License Area: -

- a) The factory premises available for Leave & License basis and area with the MAIDC shall be clearly marked.
- b) This includes built up area of main plant, area for office purpose, raw material go down, and finished goods go down approximately measuring 3000 sq. ft.

12. License Fee: -

- a) The Bidder shall pay The MAIDC a monthly license fee towards the factory premises, Go down premises on Leave & License based on 'Sugras' Animal Feed License Fee, as agreed and decided Rs.37.27/- Per sq.ft per month plus applicable GST at extra and as revised by the govt. from time to time.
- b) Leave & License fee shall become due and payable in advance, on or before 10th day of every calendar month, during the period of Leave & License.
- c) There shall be 5% increment in leave & license fee after completion of first four years, there after every years.
- d) If bidder's failed to pay the terms for consecutive 03 months during leave & license period then MAIDC may terminate leave and license agreement.

13. A) Leave & License Period: -

- a) The period of Leave & License shall be of minimum 10 years and may be further extended for mutually agreed period.
- b) The Leave & License lock in period shall be Minimum 7 years for both the bidder and the MAIDC.

13. B) Termination Clause:- The MAIDC may terminate the leave & License Agreement if,

- a) Production of other than Drip, Sprinkle Irrigation, HDPE pipe and all other agro-engineering implements without consent of the MAIDC.
- b) The successful bidder fails to pay in advance Leave & License fee to the MAIDC for more than three months.
- c) No other party shall abruptly terminate Leave & License agreement without the consent of either party.

14. Working Capital: -

- a) The raw material purchases required for the MAIDC products as well as bidders own products shall be the responsibility of the bidder, as per requirements and on appropriate time.
- b) Variable overheads, fixed overheads, human resource, spare parts, repairs & maintenance of plant & machinery for day-to-day operations shall be the responsibility of the bidder.
- c) The MAIDC shall not be the part of any of the day-to-day operational nature of any expenses at any stage of operations.

15. Factory Capacity Enhancement, Modernization and Up gradation: -
- The bidder shall install its own production line and plant machinery to meet the demands of the MAIDC brand products as per BIS Standards or the bidders own brand products.
 - The bidder shall bear installation and operational costs which may be incurred for the installation of machinery at the AEW Leave & License premises.
16. Sole Supplier Commitment: -
- The MAIDC shall have absolute possession and title over its factory which shall be made available on leave and license basis to the bidder on long term basis.
 - To continue the long-term relations, The MAIDC shall be bound to manufacture Drip, Sprinkler irrigation, HDPE Pipes and all other agro-engineering implements from successful bidder during the Leave & License period
 - That the sole supplier commitment shall be unconditional without any prejudice of the MAIDC and the bidder.
17. Infrastructure and Utility: -
- The MAIDC shall provide infrastructure including electricity connection, water connection, internal roads and all other common facilities required for operations of the Factory.
 - The bidder shall install sub-meter for electricity, water etc. for separation and calculation of the charges to be paid such bills to the MAIDC.
18. The MAIDC Purchase Rates: -
- The MAIDC brand Drip, Sprinkler, HDPE Pipes and all other agro-engineering implements purchase rates shall be decided as per L1 rates of the commercial bid.
 - The MAIDC Purchase rates shall be revised as per the fluctuations in raw materials costs, electricity, transportation costs and variable & fixed overhead costs (Price if +/- 10% variation in cash)
 - That successful bidder fails to supply the products as per requirements of the MAIDC at L1 rates of commercial bid, then MAIDC shall have liberty to buy the required products from any other supplier from the market.
19. Sales Requirement and Supply:-
Sales Requirement and supply means Sales, requirement & supply to & of open market, co-operatives, semi govt., govt. institutes & organizations and for export purpose.
20. Payment to Bidder: -
MAIDC shall pay within 30 days from the date of supply to the successful bidder for MAIDC brand products supply.
21. The MAIDC Margin: -
The MAIDC shall have the liberty to decide the selling rates with appropriate margin for its own Brand of products from time to time.
22. Joint Marketing: -
- The MAIDC and the bidder shall jointly put-up efforts for marketing of the products to promote the sales.
 - The MAIDC and the bidder shall also jointly put their best efforts to increase the business turnover on periodically basis.
23. Quality Assurance from the Bidder : -
- The Bidder shall be sole responsible for supplying the BIS standard products to the MAIDC.
 - The MAIDC shall depute its own quality control officer for the quality inspection at the time of production for supervising the production as per BIS standards.
 - The quality of the finished goods shall be ascertained before the dispatches of the finished goods.
 - Periodically and randomly the MAIDC shall draw samples for in house testing.

- e) The bidder shall install in house laboratory as per BIS standards at its own cost.
- f) The Bidder shall be sole responsible for obtaining the BIS license for its own brands products.
- g) The responsibility of the MAIDC brand products quality shall be of the Bidder only.
- h) The quality complaints shall be resolved by the Bidder at its own cost.

24. Packing & Packing Material: -

- a) Bidder shall supply the products in packing as prescribed by the MAIDC.
- b) No additional costs shall be paid by the MAIDC for the packing materials to the Bidder.

25. Indents & Demands: -

- a) The MAIDC shall indent for the products requirement with the Bidder.
- b) The bidder shall supply the products within a period mentioned there on delivery orders or indents.

26. Records & Data: -

Bidder shall have to furnish the required productions & dispatches data as per requirement of the MAIDC at any time.

27. Availing Other Facilities: -

If the bidder desires to utilize extra facilities like laboratory, spare parts etc., the bidder shall be liable to pay for the same at the mutually agreed rates.

28. Factory Hand over: -

- a) It is agreed and understood by the bidder that upon expiry of the term of leave and license, the bidder shall be liable to peacefully vacate and hand over vacant occupation of the factory to The MAIDC without fail.
- b) However, upon expiry of the period of operations, both the parties are at liberty to renew the agreement for a further mutually period and terms.
- c) That if at all, both the parties doesn't reach on renewal consensus and the bidder has invested heavy in the factory and efforts to increase the business turn over, the first right of refusal shall be of the bidder.
- d) That on termination of leave and license agreement, bidder shall hand over vacant occupation of the factory premises within three months. Otherwise, the bidder shall be liable to pay the MAIDC, leave and license fee as applicable from time to time.

29. Statutory Liabilities: -

- a) All statutory payments of workers likely to be engaged by the bidder like Provident Fund, minimum Wages, E.S.I.C. and other compliance under labor laws shall be paid without any default or demur by bidder only.
- b) The liability under Workman Compensation Act with regard to the employees engaged by the bidder during the period of agreement shall be entirely of the bidder in all respect.
- c) That the leave and license agreement shall and does not create any employer employee relationship between the parties nor the MAIDC shall be construed as Principal Employer in any manner whatsoever.

30. Entries and Discipline of Employees Engaged by Bidder: -

- a) All the Officers/employees engaged by bidder during the period of agreement, shall be required to submit valid identity proofs, if required by the factory manager of the MAIDC.
- b) That all Officers/employees likely to be engaged by the bidder during the period of the agreement, shall not be involved in any intoxicant, immoral, unethical, illegal and criminal activities.

31. Confidentiality: -

- a) The MAIDC shall provide quality/specifications and other trade secrets for its own dispatches and sale, the bidder shall not disclose above such any matter to any third party or for its own business practices or otherwise, and shall bound to keep as “classified and confidential” among bidder and the MAIDC.
- b) The bidder shall not indulge in any unfair trade practices in the marketing and sales jurisdiction of The MAIDC that is detrimental to the interest of the MAIDC.
- c) That up on expiry of term of agreement, the bidder shall return all the confidential documents related to quality or specifications.
- d) It is necessary that the bidder shall adhere and follow legal metrology for packing, batch number, date of manufacture, max retail price etc. and that same shall be in accordance with The Legal Metrology Act, 2009 and the standards of weights and Measures Act, 1976.
- e) The bidder shall be bound to follow the directions/orders issued by Govt. from time to time, regarding the use of raw materials and production.
- f) The bidder shall also liable to manufacture the products of the MAIDC to the best of workmanship.
- g) Revision or change in specifications shall be informed by the MAIDC to the bidder from time to time.

32. Competitive Selling of Bidders Brand Products: -

- a) The bidders shall not sale its own brand products to the Dealers of the MAIDC.
- b) No hidden profits/Benefits shall be passed to the MAIDC dealers by the bidder.
- c) The Bidder shall not sale its own Brand products in open market below the prices and sales policy of the MAIDC brand products.

33. The Bidder covenants with The MAIDC as under: -

- a) That the bidder has requisite experience, competence, expertise and capacity to operates the factory safely and without causing any damage to the existing plant facilities.
- b) That the bidder shall use the factory premises of The MAIDC with due care and caution, thenormal wear and tear accepted.
- c) Bidder shall always keep The MAIDC duly indemnified from all claims, damages etc. during the period of operations.
- d) The bidder shall not be entitle to create any charge, over the property of The MAIDC by executing Deed of Hypothecation or Deed of Mortgage.
- e) That the bidder shall not cause any harm, injury or nuisance to the neighboring land or of human dwellings during the period of agreement.
- f) That the bidder shall not store any hazardous or obnoxious substances any or banned products which are dangerous to the life or property in the said premises.
- g) That the MAIDC, its employees or dealers shall be entitled to enter, visit and inspect the said premises and said factory at all reasonable times of the day during the term of agreement.
- h) The bidder shall not be permitted to enter in to third party agreement or sub-License at any time during the term of leave and license without the written permission of the MAIDC.

34. The MAIDC does hereby covenant with the Bidder as under:-

- a) The MAIDC shall at its own cost obtain and maintain necessary licenses, permits, consents, approvals or certificates necessary under the applicable laws from the relevant Government or local authorities or other competent authorities for leave and license

operations of the factory for its own brand products only.

- b) The MAIDC shall be liable to pay government and statutory license fees for obtaining necessary licenses, permits, consents, approvals or certificates.
- c) It would not be mandatory for the bidder to retain any of the technical, non-technical, skilled, unskilled personnel/labor of the MAIDC.
- d) Bidder on its own discretion may appoint the above said personnel/labors but only by abiding to the laws applicable from time to time.

35. Insurance Payments: -

Insurance Payment as applicable from time to time for raw materials and other necessary nature shall be born and paid by bidder.

36. 1. Dispute Resolution: -

1.1) Any dispute, difference or controversy of whatsoever nature howsoever arising under or out of or in relation to this agreement (including its interpretation) between the parties and so notified in writing by either party to the other party (the "Dispute"), shall in the first instance be attempted to be resolved in accordance with the conciliation procedure set forth in clause 1.2 below.

1.2) The parties agree to use their best efforts to resolve all Disputes arising under or in respect of the leave and license operations promptly equitably and in good faith and further agree to provide access during normal business hours to all non- privileged records, information and data pertaining to any dispute.

2. Arbitration: -

2.1.) Any Dispute which is not resolved amicably by mutual discussion shall be finally decided by reference to Arbitration by appointment of mutually agreed arbitrator

2.2) Arbitration shall be conducted as per Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

2.3) The venue of Arbitration shall be at Mumbai.

2.4) The language of Arbitration Proceedings shall be English.

2.5) The Arbitrator shall make a reasoned award (the "Award").

2.6) Any Award made in any Arbitration held pursuant to the clause 2.1 shall be final and binding on the both the parties and the parties undertake to implement such Award without delay.

2.7) The agreement and the rights and obligations of the parties shall remain in full force and effect, pending the Award in any Arbitration proceedings hereunder.

37. Force Majeure: -

- a) The Bidder and The MAIDC shall not be liable for any financial loss, damage, injury or delay due to any cause beyond its control including (without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing expression) any act of war, external aggression, terrorism, vandalism, riot, civil commotion, sabotage, fire, flood, explosion, earthquake, pandemic, epidemic, quarantine restriction, or

Other act of God and Government (Force Majeure event).

- b) In the event of any damage during the term of operations, due to a Force Majeure event, such as to make the use of the factory impractical and unfit for a continuous period of 6 months, then either Party shall be entitled to forthwith terminate the operations notwithstanding any other provisions herein contained by giving to the other party 30 days previous notice in Writing and on such termination, all the consequences of termination provided below shall follow.
- c) In the event that the factory damaged due to Force Majeure event, the bidder shall not be liable to pay license fee and charges payable by it pro rata with respect to the portion of the damage by the Force Majeure event.

38. Applicable Laws & Court Jurisdiction:-

- a) The operations shall in all respects be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws in force in India.
- b) The Courts at Mumbai shall alone and exclusively have jurisdiction over the matter arising out of the leave and license operations.

39. Stamp Duty & Registration: -

- a) The stamp duty and registration charges in respect of the Agreement as may be applicable shall be paid and borne by the bidder

40. Each party shall, bear and pay their respective Advocates and Solicitors costs and charges Agreement Possession & Amendment in Terms & Conditions: -

- a) The MAIDC shall retain and store the original copy of the Agreement to be signed, in its custody.
- b) The MAIDC shall have full rights to amend, alter, modify and change or add any terms of the leave and license operations, if necessary, with mutual consent of the bidder.
