GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF e - TENDER FOR 2017-18

1. **Only the manufacturer of Agro Engineering products hereafter named as “Tenderer”** can participate in e-Tender.
2. A) In case of Agro Engineering Imported Products which are tested at G.O.I. authorized FMTTI centers and having valid certificate, applicant of such test report will only be eligible for participation. However applicant should have sufficient service centers in Maharashtra and have authorization certificate from basic manufacturer.
2. B) Tender Documents must be signed and self attested only by the authorized person of manufacturing unit.
3. **Tenderer has to submit tender on online e-Tender process and upload documents shown in Envelope T1, Envelope C1 & Submit the hard copies of same before technical bid opening.**
4. The Tenderer who technically qualify are eligible for opening of Commercial bid.
5. The Tenderer has to submit the detailed cost analysis of each implement in the format given in Annexure- E such as raw material, labour cost, transport expenses any other charges with reasons, and with documentary proof with present market price, M-VAT, GST. Etc. along with dealer pricelist and open market prices in Commercial bid.
6. If any Tenderer submits incomplete documents in tender for any implement then that implement will not be considered as valid and will be treated as rejected. **Documents submitted after tender submission due date, will not be accepted and considered as rejected.**
7. **The e-Tender should be submitted on online e-tender process as per tender time schedule. (Key Dates).**
8. If any Tenderer has been blacklisted or Proposed by any Govt. Dept/Corporation for black listing then such Tenderer will not be eligible for participation in tender.
9. The Tenderer should have inspection facility required for inspection of their product as per BIS norms; in case of BIS Mark equipments and basic inspection facility for Non BIS equipments at works site. Corporation holds right to inspect Manufacturing Unit and may inspect the units if felt necessary at any time during agreement or pre-agreement period. List of testing facility and inspection instrument should submit in Technical bid.
10. All FMTTI and as per Ltr. No. 13-12/2012- M &T (I & P) of Department of Agriculture and Cooperation Government of India, New Delhi, has authorized College of Agriculture Engineering and Technology, Junagarth Agriculture University, Junagarth, Gujarat, Central Institute of Agriculture Engineering (ICAR) Berasia Road, Bhopal, MP from 01-04-2015 and Farm Machinery Testing, Training & production centre under Department of Farm Power & Machinery Dr. PDKV Akola Maharashtra from 24-07-2015 to test all types of plant protection equipment operated by manually, battery and power except Boom

type power sprayers to till further orders. Hence the Tenderer can submit test report of their model plant protection equipment operated manually, battery and power except Boom type power sprayers.

11. The Tenderer applied for test report should have date of acknowledgement along with receipt from testing centers before the publishing date of Tender. But they will be eligible for supply on production of final test report only.

12. **Design & Specification** :

- a) In case of Non BIS Mark products, the Tenderer should submit Drawing/ Design and specifications with detailed test reports of FMPTTI or Institutes approved by Govt. of India shown in Annexure- D with compliance report, if not given in test report.
- b) The Implements which are imported or assembled with imported parts, tenderer should submit valid import license, latest Bill of Entry/Lading etc. with Engineering design, specifications of every part, its capacity the category by which is standard they are tested. In absence of latest Bill of Entry/Lading the tender for that product will not be considered.
- c) Only copy of certificate in token of Test report (only one page report) will not be considered & such item will be deemed as invalid.
- d) The power operated thresher, sugarcane crusher & chaff cutter are covered under purview of Dangerous Machines (Regulation) Act 1983. It is therefore, be ensured that these equipment confirm to necessary requirements of Dangerous Machines (Regulation) Rules 2007 published vide Gazette Notification No. G.S.R. 506 (E) dated 24th July 2007 or as modified from time to time.
- e) Implements having test reports of testing institutes whose approval is cancelled by Govt. of India will not be considered.

13. The Implements/ Equipments are having I.S.I. mark, Tenderer should submit the certified copy of valid B.I.S. license with I.S. No. & valid I.S.I. certificates of specific Implements/ Equipments with C.M.L no. and Endorsement for product approved and added if any. The address on B.I.S. certificates should be same where the Implements/ Equipments are actually manufactured.

14. For the Implements developed & manufactured by with State Agril. University Central Institute. The copy of MOU to be submitted along with Detailed drawing & specification The responsibility of quality will be of concern Manufacturer only.

15. **MANUFACTURING CAPACITY** :

Itemwise quantities of Implements / Equipments that can be supplied by the tenderer per month (Monthly Production) should be clearly indicated in Technical offer i.e. Envelope "A" In last 3 year's sales made by the tenderer in open market and Govt.Schemes should also be indicated.

16. **WARRANTY** :

Tenderer will have to give a warranty of at least one year from the date of supply to customer for manufacturing defects and workmanship as well as for operation. Repairs/Replacement /Servicing shall be given free of cost within the warranty period. Complaint should be attended within 7 days from the date of communication. If the complaint is not attended by Tenderer within stipulated period, the cost of that implement will be recovered from Tenderer's payment.

17. VALIDITY :

The offer prices will be valid for 90 days from the date of opening of the tender. The rates quoted shall be applicable for one year i.e up to 30.6.2018 except for Tractors & Power Tillers.

The Tenderer whose offer is accepted, must execute an agreement on stamp paper of requisite value according to the terms and conditions stipulated by the Corporation. The Tenderer shall not enter into the agreement with other Institutions/Agencies and shall not quote his rates directly or indirectly to the Institutions/Govt. Departments/Zilla Parishad's in Maharashtra.

The Tenderer shall not directly or indirectly deal with any of the Govt. Department, Semi Govt. Institutions, Zilla Parishad's, Block Development Officers etc. in Maharashtra for the items quoted. Such Tenderer will not be considered for further supply.

18. INTEREST-FREE SECURITY DEPOSIT / PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE :

The Tenderer will initially deposit Rs.10,000/- towards interest free security deposit / Performance Guarantee by Demand Draft drawn in favour of MAIDC Limited payable at Mumbai by RTGS. The limit of security deposit / Performance Guarantee of Rs. 10,000/- is applicable for the supplies worth Rs. 20/- Lakhs effected during contract period. As soon as the supply limit of Rs. 20/- lakhs is crossed, additional security deposit / Performance Guarantee @ 1% on increased value will be deducted proportionately from the payment of the Tenderer and will be credited to security deposit account of the Tenderer. The additional security deposit / Performance Guarantee deduction will be limited to maximum of Rs. 1.00 Lakh (i.e. up to total turnover of Rs. 1.00 Cr and above in the contract period). The Tenderer whose turnover in last three years is more than Rs. 1.00 Cr. will be required to deposit an amount of Rs. 1.00 lakh towards the security deposit/Performance Guarantee. The security deposit / Performance Guarantee will be returned to the Tenderer after satisfactory completion of the contract.

The Corporation shall also be entitled to deduct from the said security deposit / Performance Guarantee any expenditure loss or damages the corporation may suffer or put to any reason or due to any act or other default by the Tenderer in respect of this agreement or any other contract and in either of the event aforesaid to call upon the Tenderer to maintain the said security deposit / Performance Guarantee at its original limit by making further deposits, provided further that the Corporation shall be entitled to recover any such claim or any sum, then due or which any time thereafter may become due from the Tenderer under this or any other contract.

19. PURCHASE RATE :

The rates should be quoted on F.O.R. destination/ Taluka basis inclusive of all octroi, transport charges, service charges, handling expenses, insurance, capital lost, cost of warranty, etc. at the destination given by the Corporation anywhere in the Maharashtra State exclusive of VAT/Excise/GST (Taxes).

Govt. of India is likely to make applicable GST effective from 01-07-2017. Prices finalized as per this tender will be revised in accordance with applicable GST Rates & Terms and Conditions of the same after due consultation with Tenderer.

The Corporation will be major supplier for Implements / Equipments on state level business. The rates quoted by Tenderer should be competitive rates and will not be more than their dealers selling rates. If the rates of their dealers are less than the corporations rate then the difference amount will be recovered from Tenderer and refunded to customer. **The commercial sheets should be attached with Dealers/Distributer Price list.**

20. DELIVERY PLACE :

Deliveries are to be effected on F.O.R. Destination basis (including all expenses) anywhere in the State of Maharashtra. The deliveries are made at Taluka or Mandal levels according to the requirements of the respective customers and hence quantity of equipment's will be delivered at each destination are likely to be in single quantity. Tenderer has to submit the list of outlets where their products will be available for delivery to farmers. Also the extent to which the material is required in single quantity can not be estimated at this stage and no claim for rate revision will be accepted on the ground that the Tenderer had to incur extra expenditure on account of deliveries in small lots.

21. RATE ADJUSTMENT :

The approved rate will be increased/ decreased, if there is a variation in statutory levies on raw materials or finished product or in the rates of iron and steel/raw materials required for the manufacture of the concerned Agro Engineering products during the Year. The revision in the rates will be made only if the variation in the cost of raw materials is more than 3% and If the Tenderer wants to claim price increase on account of increase in prices under this clause, he should submit his claim with valid supporting documents immediately, however no price increase claim shall be accepted with retrospective effect.

22. SUPERVISION AND INSPECTION :

Without prejudice to the Corporation's right mentioned elsewhere in the agreement (i.e. warranty) the Corporation reserves the right of Inspection of goods before dispatches. To inspect the material before dispatches, on manufacture of the goods the Tenderer will carry out inspection for quality & specification and issue self certification with Sr. No, Batch No.etc. If required necessary instructions as regards to inspection will be issued while placing the orders and it should accordingly be ensured that the inspection is carried out by Inspecting representative before dispatches or at receiving points as the case may be. Self certified goods supply to the customers will randomly be inspected for it's quality and specification and at such after supply inspection of good's are not found as per self certification then in such case Tenderer will be bound to face legal action as per law.

23. LABELLING / EMBOSSING :

All Implements/Equipments being supplied under this tender (except Sickles & Garden Tools) should emboss or labels with Name of the Company , Brand name, Implement code no. given to the implement by testing institute.

It is a mandatory term to fix up such label on all Implements.

22. **DELIVERY SCHEDULE :**

Deliveries should be given on F.O.R. Destination basis as per the delivery schedule given in the orders placed against agreement from time to time. The delivery schedule will be given in the orders after taking into account the manufacturing capacity of the Tenderer given in the tender and as per market requirement.

In case, it is not possible for the Tenderer to effect delivery within the delivery schedule indicated in the order for any valid reasons, the Tenderer should within one week of placement of purchase order approach for extension of delivery schedule. The Corporation shall in such an event have an option to either cancel the order and purchase goods from other Tenderer at his risk & cost or give the required extension in delivery schedule.

In order to facilitate timely supply and grab the opportunity to maximize the sale the Tenderer can supply place / stock of implement/equipment at Taluka/ District or RO level stocking in consultation with ROs of corporation.

In such cases the stock will be stored at the centers on consignment basis and sales supplies to the customer will be /can be effected from this consignment stock by the corporation/ Taluka center /RO from time to time as per the demand of customers. Supplies effected from this consignment stock will be regularized by the RO by issuing indent to HO for said sold out of stock and purchase orders against these indents by the HO to the Tenderer. For any quantity of sales against these supplies at actual storage date will not considered for payment but actual sale date from the consignment stock will be considered for payment to the Manufacturer/supplier.

23. **COMPLETION OF SUPPLY / PURCHASE ORDER**

In a Purchase Order, supply at various destinations are covered hence only on supply of entire quantity at all destinations, the Order will be treated as completed. The Tenderer/ will demonstrate / install the products to customer at his cost, after supply of products whenever necessary. If complaint regarding Installation and commissioning arises from customer then the Tenderer will be responsible for future complications.

24. **DELIVERY CHALLANS OF MAIDC :**

Since the supplies are made on behalf of MAIDC, MAIDC will provide Delivery Challan Books in prescribed formats to Tenderer. Delivery challans are to be prepared from this Books only at the time of actual dispatch after self inspection by Tenderer and also clean acknowledgement is to be obtained with Date of Receipt, Stock Book Page No. If any and Signature in the space provided in Challan. No. Overwriting is not acceptable anywhere in D.C.

25. **AFTER SALES SERVICE**

For after sales service and warranty Tenderer should submit list of their dealer/authorized service centre in each Taluka & District otherwise tender will be considered incomplete.

26. **PACKING :**

The Implements / Equipments will have to be packed along with necessary tool kit and leaflets with each of the Implements / Equipments in a suitable packing and operator manual. Failure to which Implement/Equipment payments against these supplies can be stopped till fulfillment of requirement.

27. **DISPATCH ADVICE :**

On actual dispatches of Implements/Equipment's Tenderer should immediately send an intimation of dispatches to Regional Offices indicating all particulars of delivery challans, lorry receipts, name of transporters, name of consignee etc. The dispatches should be made to the destinations indicated in the respective orders. The Corporation shall not be responsible for any consignment dispatched/delivered to the destination other than specified by the Corporation and in case such wrongly dispatched consignment and delivery by the Corporation or its consignee, the expenditure incurred by the consignee or Corporation on re- Transportation of such material will be responsibility of the Tenderer/. The Tenderer shall obtain clean acknowledgement for receipt of the material in good condition from the consignee and forward the same to our Regional Office for preparation of Goods Receipt Note in the prescribed format which is to be obtained by Tenderer from corporation.

28. **REJECTION :**

The Tenderer must supply the goods according to the specifications given in the contract both in respect of quality of the product & packing material. If the goods or the packing material is not according to the specifications and/or of good quality, after supplying to destination the consignment is liable to be rejected and returned to the Tenderer at his risk and cost. In case the supplies do not confirm to the quality that has been agreed to supply, the Corporation shall be at liberty to reject the entire goods and / or accept only those goods which are in conformity with the ordered quantity. Such rejected goods, if any, shall be removed by the Tenderer at his risk and cost within the prescribed time limit. In such cases where the stocks are rejected, the Tenderer shall make the fresh supplies confirming to the ordered quantity within the prescribed time limit. No extension of time limit in delivery schedule shall be granted in such cases.

29. **PENALTY :**

In case of default on the part of successful Tenderer to supply the goods either in full or in part according to the delivery schedule, the Corporation will have an option to either.

- a) Accept the goods by levying penalty @ 0.5% of the value of the delayed supplies for every week of delay. The maximum penalty being restricted to 5% of the value of the goods delivered late,

OR

- b) To purchase balance quantity from other sources at the risk and cost of the Tenderer and recover from him the additional expenditure incurred in making alternate purchases,

OR

- c) Cancel the order in part or full for the balance quantity not supplied within the delivery schedule and forfeit security deposit.

30. **PAYMENT : Within 30 days :**

- A) Tenderer will have to submit invoice in triplicate to our Head Office duly supported by a copy of self certified inspection report with D.C. acknowledgement on receipt of full payment from concerned authorities
- B) Payment shall be made after regularization of transaction by Regional Office for consignment basis material supplied by Tenderer and in confirmation of receipt of amount from the concerned authorities.
- C) Payments against supply will be made in 30 days from receipt of Invoice, acknowledgement and all relevant documents required for payments at H.O. However no interest will be applicable for the payment delayed beyond 30 days due to either documents or any other reason.

31. **DISPUTE :**

In case of any dispute, the decision of the Managing Director of this Corporation will be final and binding upon the concern Tenderer. The Tenderer will take full responsibility of providing after sales services and warranty obligations. In case the customer is not satisfied with quality of GOODS or with the after sales services provided by the Tenderer and he approaches to the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Forum or any such body against MAIDC, the liability of paying losses, expenses /costs if any will rest with the Tenderer.

32. **GENERAL :**

During the currency of the contract, the Tenderer shall not supply similar equipment to any of his customers, dealers or distributors in the country at a price net of commission lower than the prices applicable for supplies to this Corporation. It shall be the duty of the Tenderer to notify to the Corporation the reduced price immediately, whenever supplies at reduced rates are made. If at any time it is noticed that the Tenderer has supplied similar equipment at a lower price during the period of this contract, such lower price shall be deemed to be the contract price from such date and payment at higher rate already made shall be recovered from the Tenderer.

33. **COURT JURISDICTION:**

In case of dispute arising regarding breach of contract, or non-supply of material or dispute of any kind of whatsoever nature, only courts in **Mumbai** shall have jurisdiction to entertain and try such disputes or claims arising there from.

34. **FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE :**

Neither party shall be liable of or any claim for loss, damage, or compensation whatever arising out of the failure to carry out the terms of this agreement when such failure is due to war, rebellion, mutiny, civil commotion, fire, riot, strike, lockout, earthquake or a major breakdown of plant or act of god, due to any restraint or regulation of the State or Central Government or local authorities, provided a notice of such occurrence is given to the either party in writing within 10 days from its happening with adequate proof.

The Managing Director of The Maharashtra Agro Industries Development Corporation Limited reserves the right to accept or reject partly or totally one or all tenders without assigning any reason. The Corporation reserves the right to divide the tender among the several Tenderers. The tenderer is bound to execute the agreement after acceptance of his tender either in full or part.
